

The NeighborWoods tree planting program is designed to help restore the tree cover in Greensboro by planting trees in neighborhoods and open space. Up to 150 trees and shrubs are planted each year through volunteer support. People of all ages and abilities are encouraged to participate in this event.

**When:** Saturday, November 3. Please plan to arrive at 8:30 AM to meet your planting team and receive instructions. Planting begins at 9 AM - until finished (usually by noon).

*Where:* Benbow Preserve, a 6.5-acre property located intended for Open Space purposes, near the intersection of Britton Street and South Side Boulevard, across from Kindred Hospital. Specific details for parking are forthcoming.

**Volunteer Duties**: Soil preparation, tree planting, mulching, tree watering. Most of the heavy digging will be completed by Dunlap Lawn Service Inc. prior to the event. Each team will plant approximately 10 trees or shrubs and will be paired with a knowledgeable Tree Planting Supervisor. Although some equipment may be available on-site, all volunteers should bring work gloves, a shovel, a 5 gallon pail or bucket and dress appropriately for the weather -we plant rain or shine. Consider bringing smaller shovels and buckets for the younger members of your team.

**Registration:** Call to register and then email or bring a completed registration form with you for each volunteer, including children. If you are volunteering with a group, please call or e-mail to register your team so we can keep you together. On the day of the event, there will be a registration table for those with completed forms and for those who need forms.
